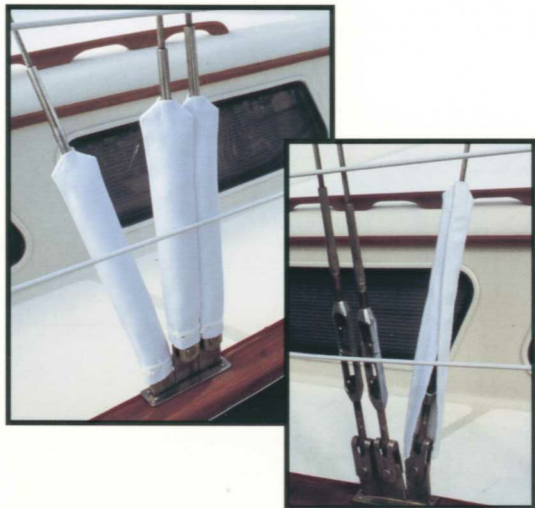


PERIMETER TURNBUCKLE COVERS



- ✦ Protect yourself and your sails from exposed Cotter Pins!
- ✦ Polyester textile will not crack, shatter or ride up the rig like PVC covers.
- ✦ More attractive, softer and easier to clean than plastic covers.
- ✦ Install standard Turnbuckle Covers when (re-)attaching turnbuckles.
- ✦ Removable Turnbuckle Covers install *without* removing turnbuckles. Polyester Velcro® fasteners allow easy installation at any time.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Standard Turnbuckle Covers:

- ① Unscrew swage stud from turnbuckle if not already disassembled. Slide swage stud through the top hole in the Turnbuckle Cover.
- ② Slide the Turnbuckle Cover down over the turnbuckle.
- ③ Use the polyester line provided to secure the Turnbuckle Cover to the toggle or mounting plate.
- ④ Spray down occasionally with a water hose to remove dust and dirt. Any common liquid soap will remove stubborn dirt.

Removable Turnbuckle Covers:

- ① Starting with the narrowed end of the Removable Turnbuckle Cover, close the Turnbuckle Cover around the swage and down the length of the turnbuckle using the Velcro® fasteners.
- ② Using the polyester line provided, secure the Removable Turnbuckle Cover to the toggle or mounting plate.
- ③ Spray down occasionally with a water hose to remove dust and dirt. Any common liquid soap will remove stubborn dirt.
- Removable Turnbuckle Covers are slightly longer than standard Turnbuckle Covers to allow usage with jaw-jaw turnbuckles and marine eyes.
