



CCF LIGHTS TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

SYMPTOMS	CAUSES	SOLUTIONS
Light won't turn ON	Switch Turned OFF Low Supply Voltage Improperly Wired Defective Lamp	Turn ON Local Light Switch Turn ON Circuit Wall Switch Recharge Batteries Verify Proper Charger Operation Reset Circuit Breaker Verify Proper Operating Voltage at Light Fixture Activate Crossover Switch (If Installed) Verify and Correct Wiring Replace Unit
Light turns ON but only half of the tube is lit	Very low Supply Voltage Defective Lamp	Recharge Batteries Verify Proper Charger Operation Activate Crossover Switch (If Installed) Replace Unit
Light makes a low pitch buzzing sound	Operating in dim mode	No remedy – A normal behavior
Light Too Dim	Ambient Temperature Too Low (Below Freezing) Dimmer Malfunction	Heat Environment to Above Freezing and Operate Light for Several Minutes to Restore Full Brightness Replace Dimmer Unit
Light Won't Dim	Improperly Wired Dimmer Malfunction	Verify and Correct Wiring Replace Dimmer Unit
