

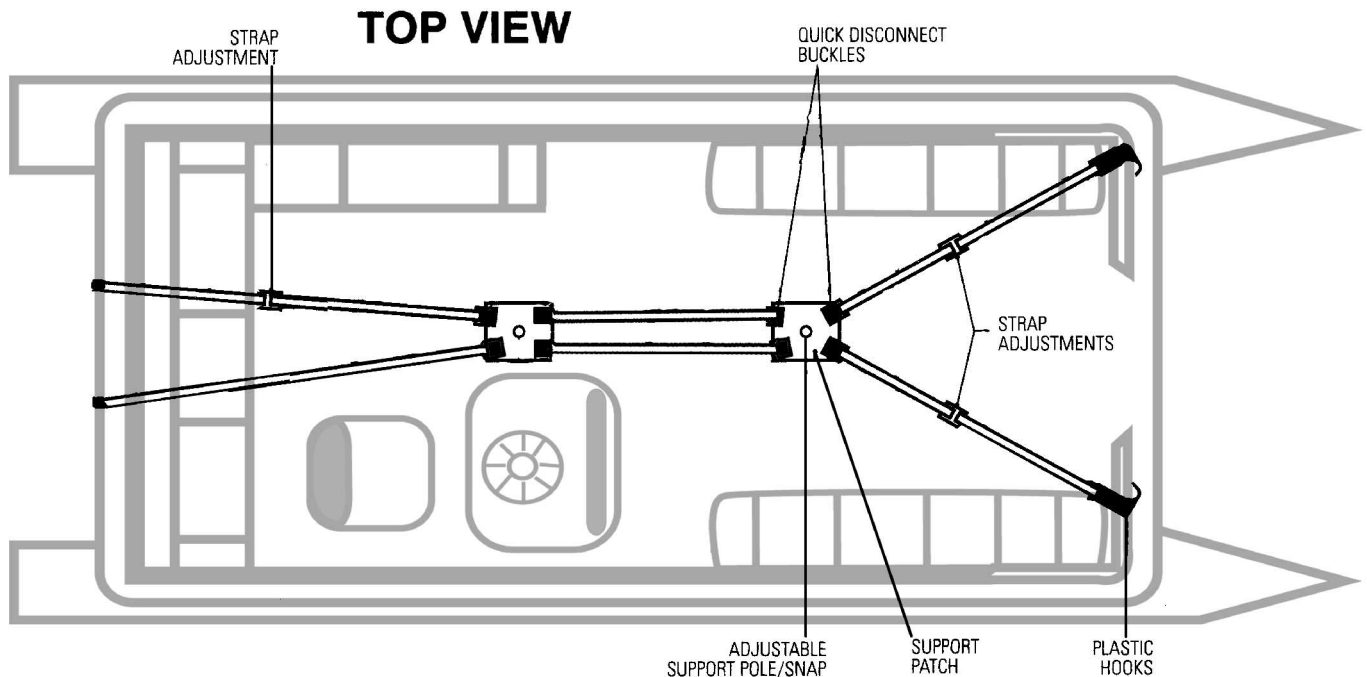

Pontoon Cover Support System

Installation Instructions

- 1.** Determine the best location within the playpen area of your boat for the two support poles. Keeping them on the centerline and spacing them to divide the playpen in thirds is the best method.
- 2.** Take the two support patch assemblies and snap to the top of the support poles. Adjust the webbing straps to the distance that the poles will be positioned. There are two straps that join the patches together.
- 3.** The other end of each of the patch assemblies has two adjustable webbing straps with a plastic hook on each end. Adjust the webbing as needed and fasten the hooks to a convenient location at each side of the stern on the playpen railing. Repeat for the two straps on the bow support.
- 4.** With the support poles in their proper positions, readjust and tighten all of the straps to apply tension. Loosen the thumb screw on each of the support poles and raise poles to desired height - retighten thumb screws to secure.
- 5.** You are now ready to place your cover onto the boat.
