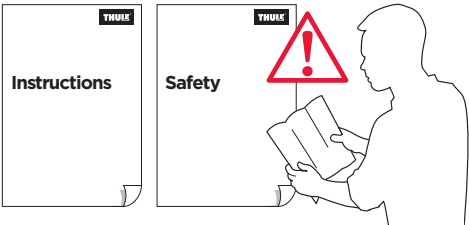

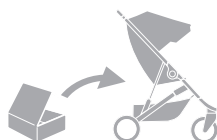

Maintenance

Keeping your Thule Spring stroller clean and well maintained is an important factor in keeping it in good condition.

Regularly inspect your stroller and accessories for damage and signs of wear:

- Check metal components for any dents or cracks. Do not use the stroller if any metal components are cracked or damaged.
- Examine the fabric regularly for tears, worn spots or any other signs of damage.

The fabrics on Thule Spring can be cleaned by hand.

- Spot clean or hand wash gently with mild soap & warm water. Do not use cleaning solvents.
- Rinse well with warm water.
- Hang to air dry completely.
- Do not machine wash! No bleach. Do not iron. Do not dry clean.
- If needed seat and canopy fabric can be removed for cleaning.

The Thule Spring chassis and wheels can be cleaned with a damp cloth. Dry it with a dry cloth.

If wheels squeak, lubricate sparingly with silicone lubricant. Do NOT use oil or grease based products, as this will attract dirt, which will clog the movement.

Store your stroller and accessories in a dry area out of direct sunlight. Before storing your stroller, it should be dry to prevent the growth of mold or bacteria.

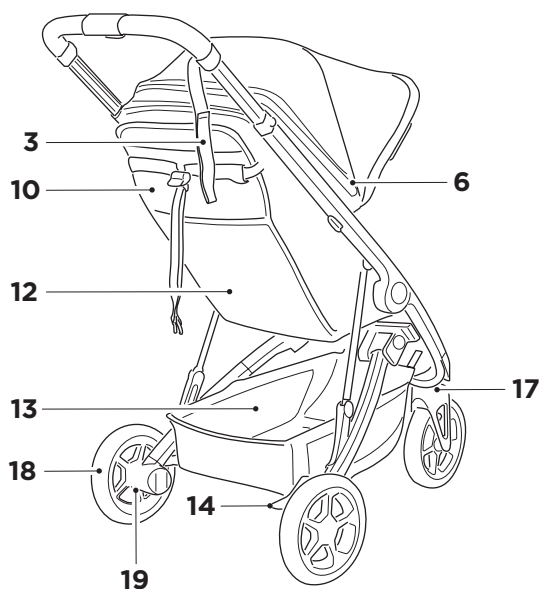
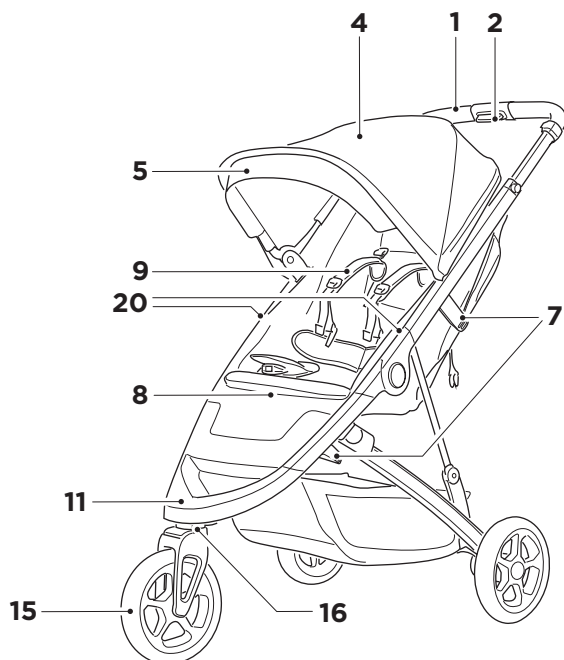

Entretien

Pour maintenir votre poussette Thule Spring en bon état, il est important de la garder propre et de bien l'entretenir.

Inspectez régulièrement votre poussette et ses accessoires pour vous assurer qu'ils ne montrent aucun signe de détérioration ou d'usure :

- Vérifiez que les pièces métalliques ne sont ni bosselées ni fissurées. N'utilisez pas la poussette si des pièces métalliques sont fissurées ou endommagées.
- Vérifiez régulièrement que le tissu ne présente pas de déchirures, d'usure ou d'autres signes de détérioration.

Le tissu du Thule Spring peut être nettoyé à la main.

- Nettoyer les taches ou lavez à la main avec du savon doux et de l'eau chaude. N'utilisez pas de solvants de nettoyage.
- Bien rincer à l'eau chaude.
- Laisser sécher à l'air libre.
- Ne pas laver en machine ! Blanchiment exclu. Ne pas repasser. Ne pas laver à sec.

- Si besoin, le tissu du siège et du canopy peut être retiré pour être nettoyé.

Le châssis et les roues du Thule Spring peuvent être nettoyés avec un chiffon humide. Essayez-les avec un chiffon sec.

Si les roues grincent, graissez-les légèrement avec du lubrifiant siliciné. N'utilisez PAS de produits à base d'huile ou de graisse, car ils attirent la poussière et encrasseraient les roulements.

Rangez votre poussette et ses accessoires dans un endroit sec, à l'abri de la lumière directe du soleil. Assurez-vous que votre poussette est sèche avant de la ranger afin d'empêcher la prolifération de moisissures ou de bactéries.

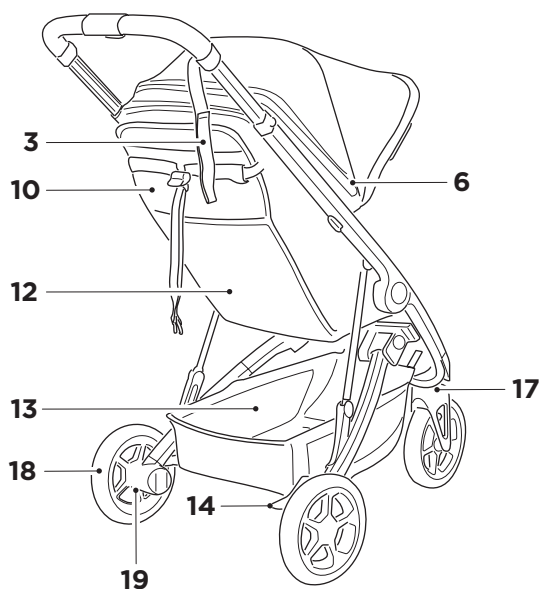
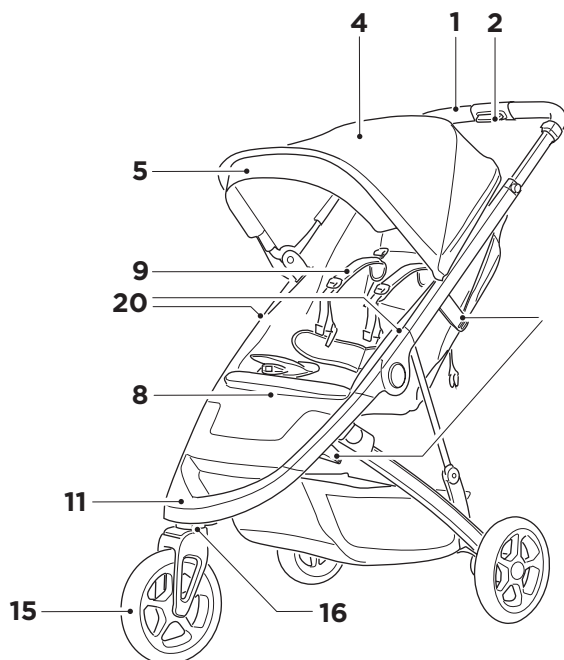

Mantenimiento

Mantener el carrito Thule Spring limpio y bien cuidado es un factor importante para conservarlo en condiciones óptimas.

Inspeccione regularmente el carrito y los accesorios por si presentan daños o signos de desgaste:

- Compruebe si los componentes de metal presentan grietas o abolladuras. No utilice el carrito si algún componente metálico presenta grietas o daños.
- Examine el tejido con regularidad por si presenta desgarros, puntos desgastados o cualquier otro signo de daño.

Los materiales de Thule Spring se pueden limpiar a mano.

- Limpie las manchas o lave a mano con jabón suave y agua templada. No utilice disolventes de limpieza.
- Aclare bien con agua templada.
- Cuelgue hasta que se seque completamente.
- No lo lave a máquina. No utilice lejía. No lo planche. No lo limpie en seco.

- Si es necesario, el material del asiento y de la capota se pueden quitar para su limpieza.

El chasis y las ruedas de Thule Spring se pueden limpiar con un paño húmedo y secar con un paño seco.

Si las ruedas chirrían, aplique lubricante de silicona. NO use productos grasos ni aceite, ya que atraerían la suciedad e impedirían el movimiento.

Guarde el carrito y los accesorios en un lugar seco y alejado de la luz solar directa. Antes de guardarlo, debe estar seco para evitar la proliferación de moho y bacterias.

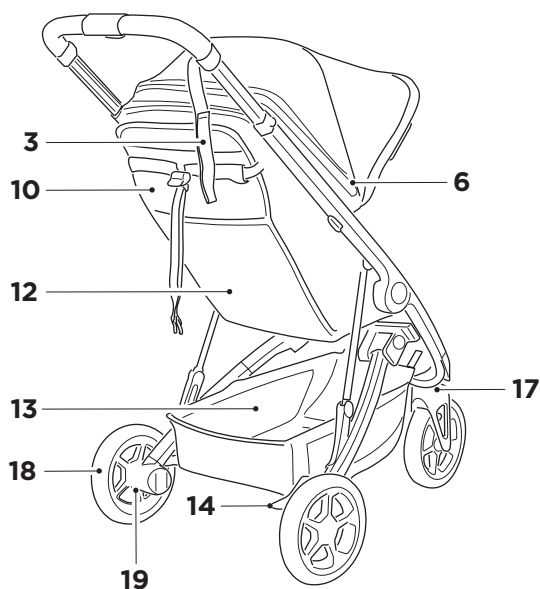
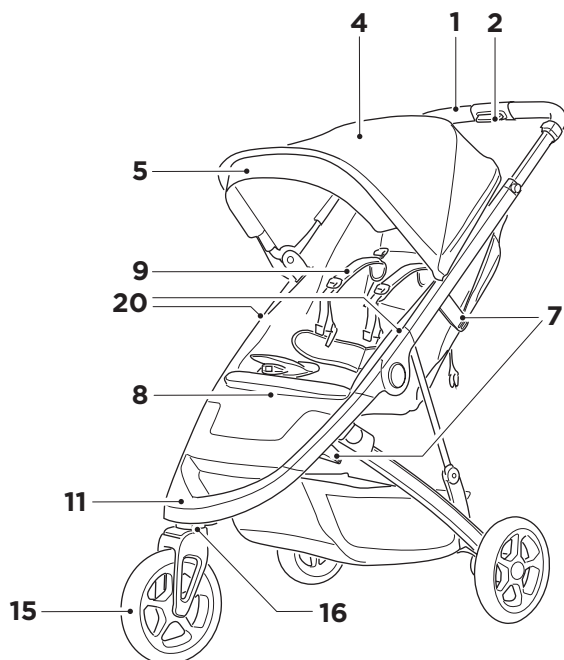

Manutenção

Manter seu carrinho para crianças Thule Spring sempre limpo e com a manutenção em dia é um fator importante para conservá-lo em boas condições.

Inspecione regularmente seu carrinho para crianças e acessórios em busca de sinais de danos ou desgaste:

- Verifique se há alguma moxa ou rachadura nos componentes metálicos. Em caso afirmativo, não use o carrinho para crianças.
- Examine regularmente o tecido em busca de rasgos, pontos de desgaste ou outros sinais de danos.

O tecido do Thule Spring pode ser limpo manualmente.

- Limpe ou lave a mão com cuidado usando sabão neutro e água morna. Não use solventes de limpeza.
- Enxágue bem com água morna.
- Pendure para secar naturalmente.
- Não lave na máquina! Não use alvejante. Não use ferro de passar. Não lave a seco.
- Se necessário, o tecido do assento e da cobertura podem ser removidos para limpeza.

O chassi e as rodas do Thule Spring podem ser limpos com um pano úmido. Seque-os com um pano seco.

Se as rodas começarem a ranger, lubrifique-as moderadamente com lubrificante à base de silicone. NÃO use produtos baseados em óleo ou graxa, pois eles causarão a aderência de sujeira, o que obstruirá os movimentos.

Guarde seu carrinho e os acessórios em uma área seca sem incidência de luz solar direta. Antes de guardar o carrinho, seque-o para prevenir o crescimento de mofo ou bactérias.
