Designed with no metallic parts for a direct replacement for steel where corrosion may not be acceptable. Locking pin can be replaced with a padlock (not supplied).

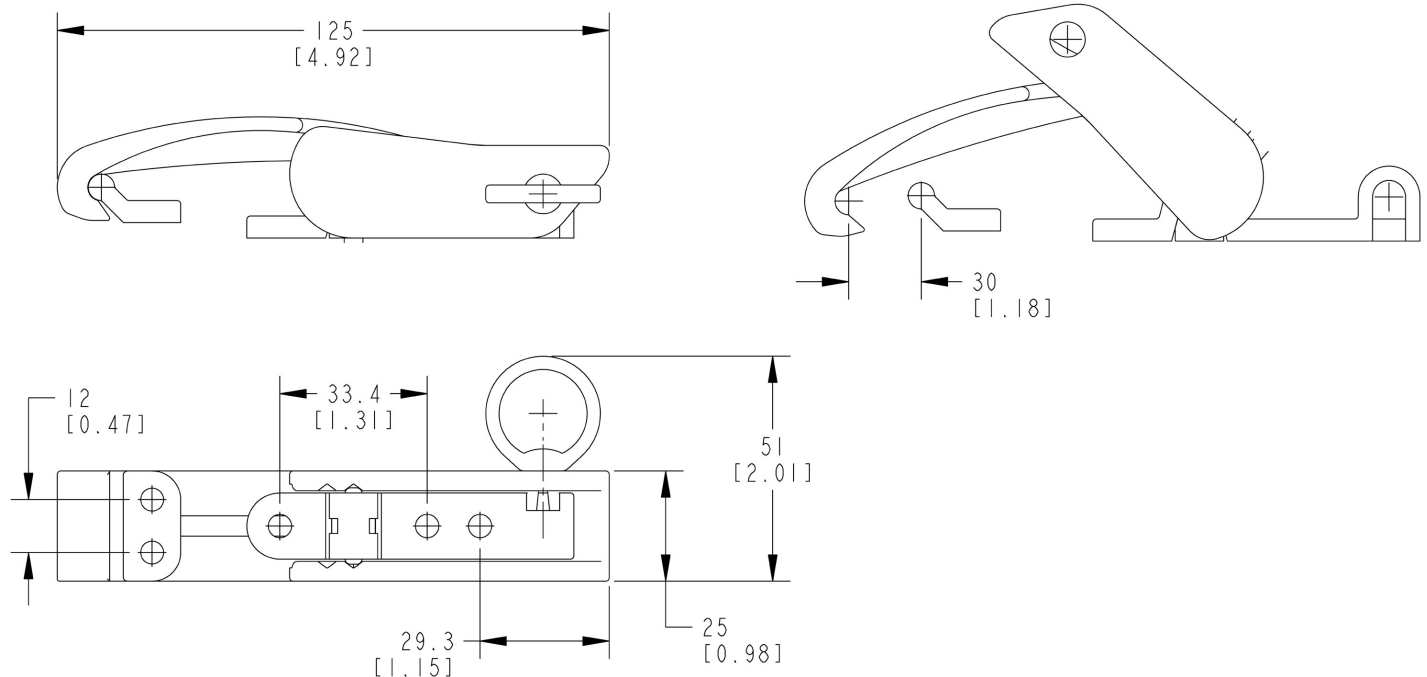
