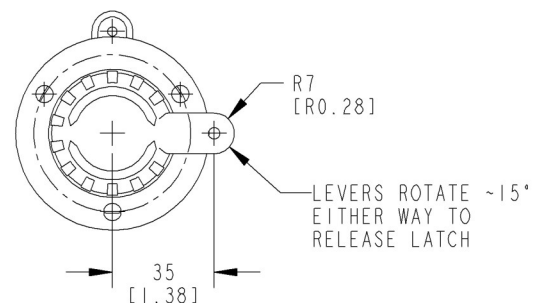
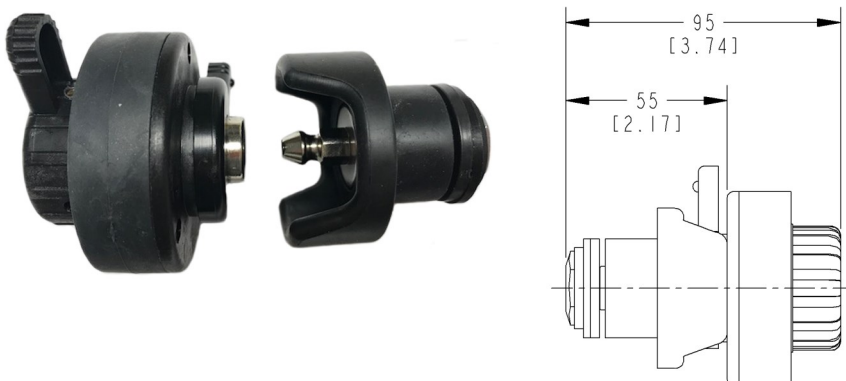
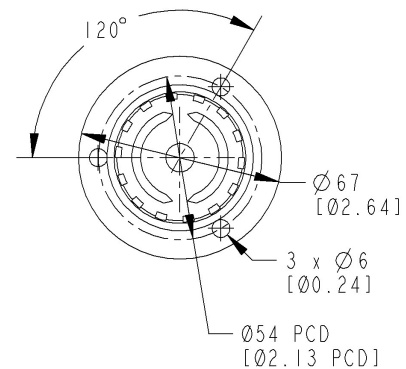
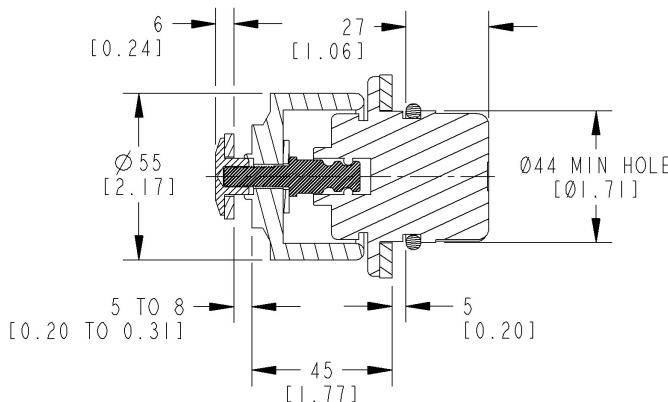
- Glass reinforced nylon - black
- Chromed steel latching pin
- Internal components: Zinc plated steel

INSTALLATION:

- Easy to install, can be mounted on glass or steel doors
- (1) Shouldered hat nut and large rubber O-ring (included)
- Recommended mounting fastener torque on strike sub-assembly to be 6.7 to 7.9 N-m (59 to 70 in. lbs.)
