This handle was designed for small compartment, access doors and tool boxes where 1/4 turn cam locking is desired. The non-locking version features a detent function in both the latched and unlatched positions.

- 90° rotation

- Handle: die cast zinc alloy
- Cam: zinc plated steel

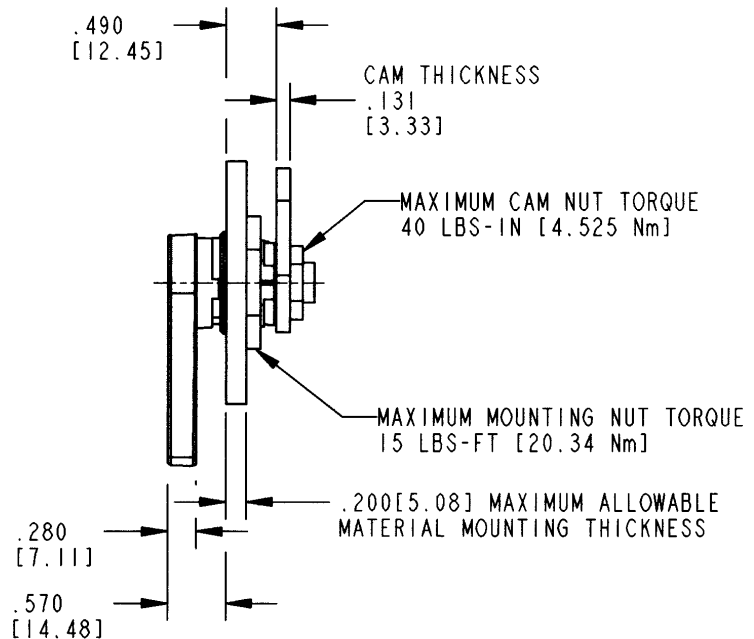
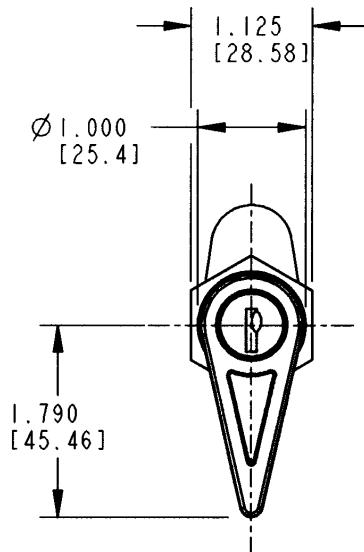
FINISH

- Black powder coated

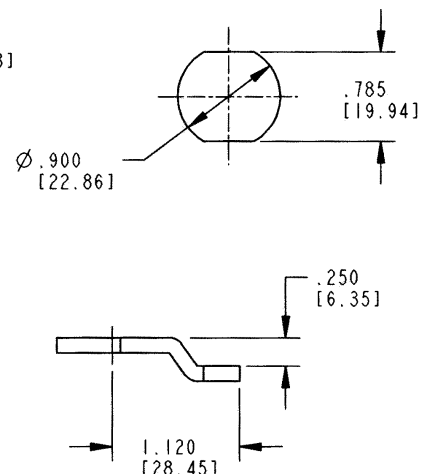
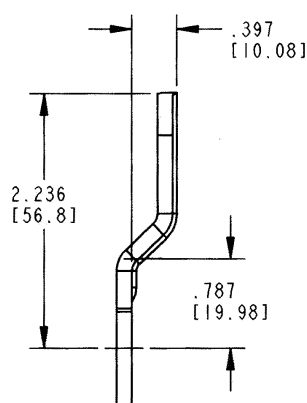
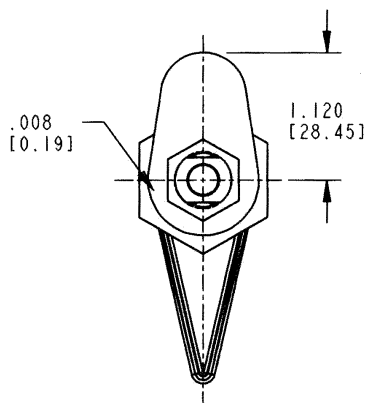
INSTALLATION:

- Supplied either fully assembled or bagged with cam and nuts packaged loose
- Removal of cam and 7/8-28 mounting nut is required for installation. IMPORTANT: Note maximum nut torque specifications below.
